Geno S. Selmo, age 93, Caspian, MI died Sunday, April 6, 2008 at the Shawano Medical Center, Shawano, WI.

The son of the late Joseph and Domenica (Signorin) Selmo graduated from Stambaugh High School in 1934. He then attended Western Michigan University, graduating with a degree in Physical Education in 1939. Geno married the former Armida Fiorani on April 4, 1944. They celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary in 1994.

He served with the U.S. Army during WWII and was honorably discharged as a 2nd Lieutenant. After he returned from the service, he worked for the Iron County Health Department until 1963 when the couple moved to Wisconsin Rapids where he was a Health Sanitarian for the State of Wisconsin. He retired in 1979 and the couple returned to the Caspian area.
